## **About the Course**

This course is designed as a transitional course for students intending to enter Latin for Children B in autumn 2023. In it, we will be reviewing five foundational concepts from Latin for Children A: 1st and 2nd conjugation verbs, 1st and 2nd declension nouns, 1st and 2nd declension adjectives, irregular and compound verbs, and prepositional phrases. The course will give students an opportunity to further solidify the foundation they have set in their studies thus far in preparation for more advanced coursework.

For students who completed Latin for Children A at Scholé Academy, this course will be a delightful review of familiar grammar and vocabulary. It will reactivate their language learning brains after time away with engaging discussions, fun activities, and fresh insights. For students who are new to the Latin for Children program or Scholé Academy entirely, this course will provide a hinge between their previous Latin studies and their entrance into the lower school Latin sequence. This course will ease their transition in the fall, allowing them to connect material between programs and integrate themselves into the Scholé Academy classroom ahead of time.

# **Eligible Students**

Rising 4th - 6th grade students who have completed Latin for Children A or a comparable course are welcome to join this course. It will be assumed that students have some exposure already to the topics that will be discussed, though have perhaps not yet attained mastery.
