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COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is an introduction to cursive writing for anyone who is interested in learning to write beautifully and increase speed. In order to have legible writing we will focus on 4 areas – shape, size, spacing, and slant.

This course can be taken by students who are younger than grade 3 or older than grade 5 if they wish to learn cursive writing; however, the grade 3-5 age range is more likely to be represented.

REQUIRED MATERIALS:

- Lined paper for cursive writing (With a solid blue top line, broken blue middle line, solid red bottom line). Spacing is best at a minimum of 1 1/2 cm from top line to bottom line, no smaller.)
- White paper
- Pencil, pencil crayons or crayons
- Folder to store work

HOMEWORK:

Students should practice their penmanship independently each day for 10-15 minutes.
