Accepted Submission Types:

- Articles on Current Events (150-500 words)
- Artwork (JPEG)
- Book/Movie Reviews and Recommendations (1-12 sentences)
- Essays (150-500 words)
- Photography (JPEG)
- Poetry (under 150 words)
- Recipes (typed up, under 450 words)
- Short stories (150-500 words)

Further notes on accepted submission types:

- Please submit written work as a **PDF**.
 - Written work should be double-spaced.
 - Poetry should be single-spaced.
- The **author's name, age/grade, and email address** should be typed at the top of the first page of the submission
 - If you are submitting artwork or photography please insert all of the above in the email you send to our Submissions Coordinator.
- Contributors are **required** to include a brief biographical note with their submissions (**1 to 3 sentences**.)
- Kids ages 4-18 are permitted to submit pieces to the Chronicle.

Themes: *We have **multiple themes** this year, which you may choose to contribute to.*

- **The special theme for this year is a column focusing on the history, stories and traditions of your family or the culture you are a part of. If you don't have an interesting family story, feel free to elaborate on the stories of other countries!** (i.e. you could write about the foods your family enjoys, you could write about art and music styles, or you could write about the traditions of a culture you admire.)
- **The seasonal column for this edition is: Autumn.** Send us your favorite autumnal recipes, a movie review, current fall fashions, photography, or poetry.
