Supplemental Tutoring

Supplemental Coaching to Support Student Coursework

- Tutor works alongside existing course instruction to provide supplemental coaching and assistance
- Tutor can provide assistance in areas of difficulty or work with gifted students to accelerate in a particular discipline
- Instruction, feedback, and assessment is provided in live, video-conference sessions (minimal out-of-session evaluation and assessment)
- Frequency of tutoring is flexible
- Sessions may be scheduled in 30- or 60-minute increments
- Sessions scheduled quarterly by tutor and parent
- Available for 1–3 students; prices vary

Pricing

- **Supplemental Tutoring for 1 student:**
 - 1–4 hours per purchase, per single student: \$50.00/hour
 - 5–8 hours per purchase, per single student: \$45.00/hour
 - 9+ hours per purchase, per single student: \$40.00/hour

Semi-Private Pricing

- **Supplemental Tutoring for 2–3 students:**
 - 1–4 hours per purchase: \$40.00/hour, per student
 - 5–8 hours per purchase: \$35.00/hour, per student
 - 9+ hours per purchase: \$30.00/hour, per student

Purchased tutoring packages do not accrue, and hours cannot be transferred to other tutoring arrangements.

Personalized Private Instruction through a Full Course of Study

- Tutor provides primary instruction in an area of study
- Tutor provides full scope and sequence of the course, complete with homework assignments, graded student submissions, assessments, etc.
- Students may earn credit for completed courses
- Includes live, video-conference sessions and out-of-session planning, assessment, and office hours
- Live meetings 1, 2, or 3 times per week; frequency established at the beginning of the course
- Sessions may be scheduled in 30- or 60-minute increments
- Sessions scheduled quarterly by tutor and parent
- Available for 1–3 students; prices vary

Pricing

- **Private Instruction for 1 student:**
 - 8–15 hours per purchase, per single student: \$55.00/hour
 - 16–23 hours per purchase, per single student: \$50.00/hour
 - 24+ hours per purchase, per single student: \$45.00/hour

Semi-Private Pricing

- **Private Instruction for 2-3 students:**
 - 8–15 hours per purchase: \$45.00/hour, per student
 - 16–23 hours per purchase: \$40.00/hour, per student
 - 24+ hours per purchase: \$35.00/hour, per student

Personalized Services for Students with Learning Differences

At Scholé Academy we firmly believe that classical education is the best education for all students, even if it is delivered or received in unique ways. We offer services delivered by a Special Needs Instructor (SNI) supporting students who have been diagnosed with Specific Learning Disorders or those who are seeking a diagnosis.

We serve students with Specific Learning Disorders (SLDs) or who are seeking diagnosis. dyslexia, ADHD, dyscalculia, dysgraphia, and processing deficits. Our program involves families working closely with a SNI to determine a correct scope of services to support the student and their experience with Scholé Academy.

We can serve students who,

- have difficulty reading (e.g., inaccurate, slow, and only with much effort)
- have difficulty understanding the meaning of what is read
- have difficulty with spelling
- have difficulty with written expression (e.g., problems with grammar, punctuation, or organization)
- have difficulty understanding number concepts, number facts, or calculation
- have difficulty with mathematical reasoning (e.g., applying math concepts or solving math problems)
- have academic skills that are substantially below what is expected for the child's age and that cause problems in school, work, or everyday activities.

Please note: The services provided through our Center for Students with Learning Differences are not intended to meet the standards of or fulfill any state's requirements. The services provided here are intended to be used as a helpful supplement and are provided to parents who are looking for an alternative to, or an addition to, state services.

 - *Free** private Initial Consultation with a Special Needs Instructor
 - Evaluation and Reporting Services, \$90.00/hour
 - Special Needs Intake Form Review, 1-hour Consultation with Special Needs Instructor: \$135

- Student Individual Accommodation Plan, 1-hour Consultation with the Special Needs Instructor: \$160
- **Special Needs Instructor Services:**
 - 8–15 hours per quarter, per single student: \$60.00/hour
 - 16–23 hours per quarter, per single student: \$55.00/hour
 - 24+ hours per quarter, per single student: \$50.00/hour
- **Special Needs Instructor Private Course:**
 - 8–15 hours per quarter, per single student: \$65.00/hour
 - 16–23 hours per quarter, per single student: \$60.00/hour
 - 24+ hours per quarter, per single student: \$55.00/hour

Personalized Instruction through a Full Course of Study

At Scholé Academy we value the benefits of online learning and are always open to exploring how we can support other schools and co-ops when a mutually beneficial solution might be a good option. On a case by case basis, we are often asked if we are able to support schools and co-ops in the classical tradition through contracting with SA Instructors for teaching assignments. Most of the time, schools/co-ops are interested in securing a Scholé Academy instructor to host an exclusive course for their private group.

Pricing

- **For School, Co-op, or Group:**

- Scholé Academy retains 60% of the tuition as a non refundable down payment.
- Students who withdraw receive a 40% refund prior to the drop deadline.
- Scholé Academy does not offer tuition discounts. Our instructors are paid on a per-student basis. This is the only way to honor our agreement with the instructors.
- Tuition per student ranges from \$665-\$775 for yearlong courses.
