WHAT TO EXPECT

This class will pick up where RF 3 leaves off. We will review the most recently learned phonograms and learn the final, advanced phonograms. Already taught spelling rules will be reviewed and any remaining spelling rules will be introduced. Due to the shortened time frame of this class, more time will be spent on mastering the rules and less on developmental activities. Etymology, Latin and Greek roots, dictionary skills, prefixes and suffixes will be covered. Spelling words will be introduced during the first class of the week and tested during the second. This will mean your child will need to practice the words during the week. After the spelling test, I will introduce the phonograms for the following week's spelling list.
